Accessible Workstation

There is an accessible workstation in the Computer Room, reserved exclusively for those who cannot work at an ordinary desk or with an ordinary computer.

The height of the top can be adjusted to suit everyone from users in wheelchairs to those who need to work standing.

The keyboard and mouse are ergonomic, and the screen is larger than normal.

Users who use an ordinary chair are invited to borrow one from another work station.

Please keep the desk clear of clutter so that it can be used by those who need it.

Other Facilities

In addition to the main accessible workstation, there are two other facilities within the Library:
