


About your stay

We offer a shared kitchen facility for your convenience. We kindly request that you clean up after yourself, disposing of any food items or refuse in the correctly designated bins provided, and placing your rinsed dishes and utensils in the dishwasher. The kitchen is a communal facility, so please be considerate of other guests, and maintain cleanliness and respect for fellow users. A washer/dryer is located in the kitchen areas, should you wish to wash any clothing during your stay.

There is an Appliance Guide in the kitchen, which explains how to use the appliances in the kitchen and your room safely. Please contact the Accommodation team if you require further guidance.

The tap water in this property is mains-fed and is safe to drink.

To allow the College to deliver quality accommodation at affordable rates, daily rubbish removal and tea and coffee refreshments are provided in each room. For stays of 7 nights or more, a complimentary full room clean, including linen and towel changes, is provided midway through the initial 7 days of your stay and weekly thereafter for longer stays. You will be notified via email before each clean. Guests staying 5 nights or more can request a complimentary room clean with linen and towel changes by emailing accommodation@kellogg.ox.ac.uk.

In the rare event that you find yourself locked out of your room, please contact the following:

They will assist you in regaining access to your accommodation. Please note: they can take up to 30 minutes to attend.

Checking out

We kindly request that all guests check out of their rooms by 10am on the day of departure. Failure to do so may result in additional charges.

You can either return your room key by placing it in the drop box located in the entrance way of the house, or by leaving it with the College receptionist.

Before leaving, please ensure that all personal items are removed from your room and the communal areas. Kindly dispose of any food items from the kitchen in the designated bins provided. Regrettably, the College does not offer luggage storage. However, suitable alternatives are available within the city, and can be reserved online.

In case of an emergency

In the event of an emergency, please follow these important contact procedures:

For immediate life-threatening emergencies, including medical emergencies or fires, dial 999 to alert emergency services. After calling 999, during daytime hours, please contact our Reception on 01865 612000. For after-hours or weekend emergencies, reach out to the Junior Dean on 07932 951849.

Non-emergency situations:

For non-life-threatening medical attention or medical advice, contact the NHS nonemergency number, 111. In the case of nonurgent police matters, please dial 101.

Regardless of the situation, we recommend also contacting the Junior Deans for assistance and guidance - 07932 951849.

For any other assistance or first aid needs, please contact our Reception or the Junior Deans who are here to help you.

Maintenance issues:

Should you notice any maintenance issues in your room, please complete our Maintenance Form, and we will endeavour to attend as soon as we can.

Personal safety advice

For your safety, always close windows and lock your room and front doors when leaving. Windows are required by law to have their opening restricted for your safety; please do not remove or tamper with them. If we see they have been removed, the Facilities team will attend to replace immediately.

Be mindful of strangers attempting to tailgate you into the property; only authorised individuals should have access. At night it is always recommended to stick to well-lit paths, and avoid secluded shortcuts. If you notice anything suspicious, contact Reception or the Junior Dean immediately. In an emergency, call 999.

Fire safety, smoking & vaping

Your safety is paramount to us. Please be aware of the following:

- Our buildings are equipped with 24/7 monitored fire detection systems.
- Familiarise yourself with fire safety measures:
 - 1. Keep fire doors closed.
 - 2. Check your room for assembly point information.
 - 3. Find red call points in corridors to raise the alarm.
 - 4. Only use fire extinguishers to aid evacuation.
- Minimise fire hazards:
 - 1. Never leave cooking appliances unattended.
 - 2. Keep flammable items away from heat sources.
 - 3. Avoid overloading sockets, and report electrical issues.
 - 4. Weekly fire alarm tests occur Fridays, 8:30am-10am.

We appreciate your cooperation. Any questions or for assistance, please contact our staff.

The use of naked flames, such as candles and oil burners, joss sticks, incense and all similar items, is strictly prohibited.

Smoking and vaping is strictly prohibited inside all College buildings. Please use the external designated smoking/vaping areas located at each College property.

Wi-Fi

TheCloud Wi-Fi is available to guests in our short-term accommodation free of charge. How to connect:

The Hub Café

Conveniently situated at the heart of the College site, our Hub Café offers hot/cold drinks, snacks, and freshly prepared sandwiches and soups. The café also offers breakfast (not included in your room booking) and brunch on weekends. The café only accepts payment by card and is cashless.

Opening hours:

Monday-Friday: 8:00am-5:00pm

Saturday & Sunday: 9:00am-3:00pm (brunch from 10:00am-1:00pm).

The Hub is also used as a venue for College events, so please check the website for ad hoc closures prior to your visit.

Heating & cooling

In line with the College's commitment to reducing carbon emissions, heating services are available from 1 October to 30 April. As is typical in the UK, the College does not have air conditioning units in any building. We appreciate your co-operation in helping us reduce our environmental impact.

Heating:

Anne McLaren House (Rooms 8-11) and Donald Michie House: Room heating is managed by a Thermostatic Radiator Valve (TRV) on each radiator. Adjust the dial, starting from the star (coldest) to 5 or Max (hottest) for your preferred temperature. The TRV is located on the bottom left or right of the radiator.

Anne McLaren House (Rooms 1–7):

Heating for these rooms is controlled using the EcoSync smart system. Please refer to the instructions located in the perspex holder on your desk for further guidance.

Cooling:

To help keep your room comfortable during the warmer summer months, we recommend keeping the curtains closed during the day to block out direct sunlight. For your safety, please ensure that window restrictors remain in place and are not removed or adjusted. We've provided a fan in each room to help improve air circulation and keep things cool.

Car parking & bicycle storage

Car parking is not available on-site at Kellogg. For guests with Blue Badge permits, we kindly request that you contact the Facilities team at the point of booking. You can reach them by emailing buildings@kellogg.ox.ac.uk.

We do, however, offer bike racks for residents to use during their stay.

Sustainable practices - helping the environment together

We are committed to sustainability, and invite you to join us in helping us improve our environmental impact.

Save energy: Turn off lights, chargers, and appliances when not in use.

Conserve water: Take shorter showers and turn off taps when not needed.

Reduce waste: Sort recycling properly into food, recycling and general waste using the guide in the kitchen and designated bins; use reusable bottles and bags.

Be heat-wise: Keep doors and windows closed when heating is on; use curtains to retain warmth.

Travel smart: Walk, cycle, or use public transport when possible.

Lost property

If an item is found in a guest room after a guest has checked out, it will be available for collection at the main Kellogg reception during regular reception opening hours.

We regret that we are unable to post items to guests. Any retrieved items will be retained for a maximum of one week. However, exceptions can be made, if required.

Behaviour

We encourage all guests to make use of our communal lounge and kitchen spaces during their stay. To maintain a peaceful environment for all, we kindly request that you keep the lounge and kitchen doors closed at all times to minimise noise. We expect all residents to be particularly mindful of noise levels between 11pm and 7am. Should you experience issues related to excessive or unwanted noise, please contact our Accommodation team via accommodation@kellogg.ox.ac.uk.

Inappropriate comments or behaviour reported to the College may result in the individual being asked to vacate their accommodation. In such cases, no refund for booked nights will be provided, and future bookings may not be available for the individual.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in ensuring a comfortable and pleasant stay for all our guests.


